

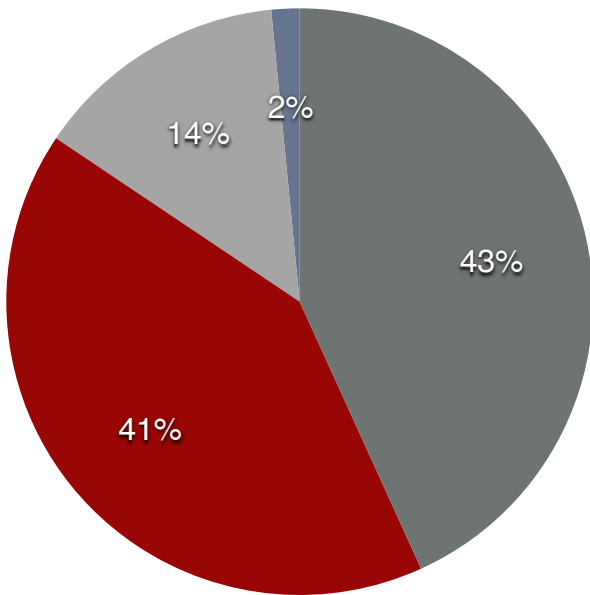

- Program expenses were \$39,990 (\$13,000 of which was allocated to The Peace Exchange)
- General contributions were \$38,132
- The Peace Exchange Contributions via Impact Giving Grant was \$13,000
- Operating Expenses were \$1,435

## The Impact of Giving in 2014

### *Organic Farming for All: Second Shared Farm*

With the addition of a second plot of land, the OFFA program is able to provide training in both the dry and rainy seasons, combatting malnutrition and poverty as women learn agricultural skills to grow food to feed their families and to sell at the market.

### *Animal Husbandry: My Goat is Your Goat*

Originating with 50 goats, the husbandry program is expanding: 31 additional families received goats, and 22 families took home a chicken. Through My Goat is Your Goat, the neighbors share the babies of the gifted goat. For a poor woman to have a goat, it gives her pride. It means: "I am somebody in the community." It is a social, community building program that engenders trust where there is so much trauma.

### *Sewing Workshop: Class of 2014*

60 girls and women graduated with sewing kits and the skills and financial literacy to start their own businesses!
